This is proven by a document known as the Charter of Gask, dated 28 Feb 1364, in which David II bestows all the lands in Gask and a Barony upon Walter Olyphaunt and his spouse "Elizabeth, our beloved sister". The original Charter was missing for 40 years, but was recovered by Laurence Oliphant in 1786. It was registered in the Books of Council and Session as a Probative Writ on 5 May, 1795 by Mr. John Pattison, advocate, and Alexander Robinson, writer, Edinburgh, Scotland. There are other documents which also confirm the relationship of Elizabeth to David II. One of them is a confirmation of the lands of Newtyle and Kinprony, granted at Edinburgh the same day as the Charter of Gask, by King David II, in which the King confirms the lands " to the said Walter and Elizabeth, his spouse, the king's sister". Another charter on the same day conveys to "Walter Olyfaunt and Elizabeth his spouse, the king's beloved sister" the lands of Turynys and Dromy, in Forfar. Although the "Book of Bruce" does not make note of which of Robert's children were of which wife, it is known that Marjory was the only child of Isobel of Mar, and that David was the son of Elizabeth de Burgh. Elizabeth, the fourth daughter of Robert, was probably younger than David and it is presumed that she was also the daughter of Elizabeth de Burgh, in part because of the generosity of David to his sister and her husband. There is information contributed by researchers on the LDS ancestral files that names Elizabeth as the daughter of a concubine, but the very fact that her name was Elizabeth, after her mother, belies that notion.

There is a dispute among researchers as to who Duncan's parents were. Many genealogies on the internet have him as the son of John Oliphant and Janet Gilchrist, who came to this country in 1685 to escape religious persecution in Scotland. A descendant who has researched their family for twenty years, Joann Bletch, says that John and Janet lost everything they owned for supporting the Presbyterian Church. Their son William was banished to the colonies for same. (William died unmarried and his property was divided among his parents and siblings. Duncan was not mentioned in his will.) The children of John and Janet are all listed in the OPR indexes, yet Duncan is not among them, according to Ken Middleton, who has searched them all. John and Janet indentured themselves and their daughters for passage to this country. They were destitute.

On the other hand, Duncan Oliphant was a member of the Church of England and an active supporter of it even after he came to this country. He was well thought of enough to be appointed Constable of Staten Island. This indicates he was not in the same dire straits as John and Janet Gilchrist Oliphant. He had the money to buy the property in New Jersey. He named his eldest son, David. Naming patterns followed in Scotland in that time period dictated that the eldest son be named after the father's father. The eldest daughter was usually named after her mother. Most families continued to follow at least some of the traditional pattern for a few generations after they came to the New World. Since so many babies died in those days and their names were not recorded for posterity, we cannot be sure there was no "Janet" in Duncan and Mary's family, of course.

I believe, though cannot yet prove, that Duncan was the son of David Oliphant, born abt 1648 in Perthshire, Scotland to Sir Laurence Oliphant and his wife, Lillias Oliphant. Sir Laurence and his cousin, Lillias, married in 1634. She was the daughter of Patrick Oliphant, heir to the Condie line of Oliphant and his wife, Elizabeth. David died in 02 Feb 1717 in Edinburgh and is buried at Greyfriars. The records of the Anglican Church at Perth are missing for the crucial years needed to find the name of David's wife

and the baptismal records of his children due to a fire.

William Oliphant was a passenger on the "Henry & Francis" in 1685. It is generally believed that he was Duncan's brother. The "Henry & Francis" was a prison ship from Scotland.

You might be interested in the following information that I have on Duncan. Two or three people gave me parts of this information.

He moved in 1721-24 to where he had purchased a large tract of land in Hopewell Township, Burlington Co, NJ (Now Amwell Twp., Hunterdon Co.) now village of Clover Hill (Lib H.H. p. 34 West Jersey Deeds 1749-Office Sect. of State, Trenton NJ) Chosen Freeholder of Amwel Twp., Hunterdon Co. (Hunterdon Co. History, p. 346)
