(5) 1742: Removed, probably with his son Jehiel, to the town of Kent, Litchfield Co., CT.

George Stocking was born in England in about 1582 and died May 25, 1683, aged 101 years. He married his wife Anna in England. He came to America with his wife and their four children in 1633 in the Ship "Griffin," which brought the Hooker Company. He built a house in Cambridge at the corner of Holyoke and Winthrop Streets. In 1636 he moved to Hartford with Hooker, being one of the original founders of what became Connecticut's capital and a prominent proprietor. His name is among the 100 cut in the brown stone obelisk erected in the old Center Church burial ground. His will made July 15, 1673, names his wife and each of his children. His only son Samuel was his chief heir and executor of his estate.

! "GEORGE STOCKING, born in England; married 1st in England, Anna _____; married 2d, in Hartford, CT, Agnes _____ (She may have been Agnes (Shatswell) Webster, widow of Gov. John Webster who died 1661). He came to Massachusetts May, 1635. Removed with the first settlers to Hartford, 1636, and had a lot of twenty acres there in the first distribution of land. Selectman in Hartford, 1647. Surveyor of highways, 1654 and 1662. Chimney viewer, 1659. Excused from military duty, 1660, probably on account of age. May, 1670, he with his second wife Agnes separated to the Second Church of Hartford. He died "at great age," May 25 1683. He left no will and his estate, which amounted to 257 pounds:09:00 was divided among his children: Samuel Stocking, Hannah Benton, the wife of John Richards, the wife of Samuel Olcott, and his grandson John Stocking. Family tradition says that he came from "west of England" and was derived from a good family there. In the older records, the name is often written Stocken or Stockin."

The distribution of land at Newtown, August 4, 1634, may indicate that the following new-comers were also passengers in one of the "fourteen great ships" that arrived in June: Joseph Easton, James Ensign, John Hopkins, Thomas Judd, Stephen Post, and George Stocking. These accessions quickened the desires of Newtown for more extensive fields.

I Samuel Stocking of Middletown do leave this my last Will & Testament: I give unto my loveing wife Bethia Stocking my whole Homestead lying on the both sides of the Highway with all ye Buildings thereon thereunto belonging, with my whole Lott in the Long Meadow, with my Lott at Pistol Poynt, & half of my Meadow lying on the other side of the Brook, that part of it that lyeth next to the Great River, with all my Meadow Lands at Wongunk, together with all my Stock & Moveables; these I give my wife during her Widowhood, and upon marrying again I Will to her oe4 yearly to be raised out of that Estate which I have agreed to my son Daniel Stocking. I give to my son Samuel Stocking my whole Allottment upon the Hill between the Land of Lt. White and Israel Willcox, only excepting 6 acres adjoining to the Land of Lt. White, which I give to my daughter Bethia. Moreover I give to my son Samuel the remaining half of the Meadow over the Brook, with 10 acres of the Swamp adjoining to it. I give him my whole Allottment at the Cold Spring on the west side of the Way to Hartford. I give to him, sd. son Samuel, the whole of my Lott at Pipe Stave Swamp, with the half of my Allottment next unto Wethersfield Bounds, with the halfe of my Lott at Pistol Poynt, upon his Mother's decease. I give unto my son John Stocking the whole of the Land and Buildings at my Father Stocking's decease bequeathed me by his last Will, within the Bounds of Hartford. I give unto my daughter Lydia my Lott lying next unto Thomas Ranny's, and butting upon ye Commons West and Dead Swamp East, with a good Milk Cow, to be delivered her within 12 months after my decease. I give to my sons George & Ebenezer all my Lands on the East side of the Great River, to be equally divided between them, excepting the 1/2 of my Great Lott next unto Haddam Bounds. I give to my son Steven my whole Lott upon the Hill, bounded upon ye Lands of Thomas Rannie North, the Commons East, West & South, with my whole Allottment in Boggy Meadow, with all my Meadow & Upland in the farther Neck, giving the Improvement of the Boggy Meadow unto my son Samuel till the abovesd. child is of age to inherit. I give to my son Samuell (Daniel, see original paper on File) my whole Homestead lying on both sides of the Highway, with my Lott in the Long Meadow, with half my Lott at Pistoll poynt, with 1/2 of my Lott lying on the West side of the way as you goe to Hartford, adjoining to the Land of Anthony Martin on the North, the Land of Thomas Ranny South, the Highway & Commons West. This I say I give to my son Daniel, that is to say, the West end of it, the other halfe of sd. Lott to be to my son Samuel. Note:

Came to North America between 1630 and 1635. An original settler of Milford CT, but was not a member of the church and not listed as an original proprietor. He was assigned 3 acres as a homestead. Joined the church in 1648. He came to New England a poor youth, and died a substantial citizen with considerable property and a large progeny. He moved to Hartford around 1660, where his wife's parents lived. Made a freeman 1665, released from the Milford church 1666.

His second wife Anne Cole, as a young girl suffered from seizures in which she spoke strange words which people could not be properly understand. It was assumed she was bewitched. An old woman named Rebecca Greensmith, already accused of witchcraft, confessed to bewitching her. This woman and her husband Nathaniel were tried and convicted and put to death for witchcraft in January 1662. The Greensmith property was sold, and part of it eventually was bought by Andrew Benton. He moved into a house on that property with his family. It was in that house that his first wife died, where he married Anne Cole, and where he and she also died. Anne's oldest child Ebenezer was feeble-minded, and in their wills she and her husband left him a larger portion of the estate so he could be properly cared for. (He was their only surviving son.)
